#### KS2 Cross Country – Monday 1st July

Pupils in Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 are invited to take part in a cross country event at Crewe Vagrants on Monday 1st July (15:30-17:30). Places for this event are limited and will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis but there are still some places available. If you would like your child to take part, consent should be given through *Clubs* on Arbor by Monday 24th June. Once the event is fully subscribed, it will no longer show on Arbor.

Parents will be responsible for transport to and from the venue. Children should be collected as normal at the end of the school day and aim to arrive at the venue as close to 15:30 as possible depending on the traffic conditions.

#### KS2 Snack and Lunch Payments – Summer 2

Snack payments are listed under the **trips** section on Arbor. If you wish for your junior child to have a snack this half term, please make payment via Arbor. The charge for each half term is £5 per child.

Please note that lunch payments should be made **in advance** via the **meals** section on Arbor. Meals are charged at £2.35 per day.

#### Attendance & Fines for Unauthorised Absence

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Office to improve our attendance and prevent children's attendance from falling below 95%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. We are contacting parents by letter if we are worried that a child's attendance is becoming close to 90%. Please be assured that this is just a process and that we are here to support families as much as we can to improve attendance.

If you intend to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a Leave of Absence Form and return this to the office. You should be aware that if your child is taken out of school and the reasons are not classed as exceptional, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. The school must then inform the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice may be issued if your child is absent for 5 days or more. Please note that letters confirming receipt of your Leave of Absence Request will only be issued if the Principal has been unable to authorise absences of 5 days or more.

We have to advise you that the Penalty Notice states that there is a Penalty to be paid of £60 per parent/carer per child to be paid within 21 days. If not paid within 21 days then the Penalty rises to £120 per parent/carer per child, up to the twenty eighth day. If full payment is not received by the twenty eighth day, then the Local Authority will prepare paperwork for a Prosecution in the Magistrates Court.


The law requires all children between the ages of 5 and 16 to be in full time education. Under Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 it is the duty of the parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age to ensure that they attend school regularly.
