Following on from our 'Positive Noticing' day last term we are now introducing positive noticing labels into our daily practice at school. Each member of staff will give their yellow label to a class who has gone 'above and beyond' with their behaviour in school and these will be celebrated in our weekly Friday assembly.

We are also introducing individual Recognition feathers which will be given to anyone demonstrating either our three golden rules or one of the 4 core elements of our school (Welcoming, Community, Limitless, Aspiration). But why feathers I hear you ask?

As you will be aware we do not believe at WCLA that children should behave in a certain way in return for a reward. We wanted to be quite clear that we are not giving out points, the children are not collecting them for a prize, instead the feathers are our way of recognising and saying thank you for the living our beliefs and being their best self ie for 'doing the right thing just because it is the right thing to do'. Joey the swan is such a key feature of our school, feathers seemed like the obvious choice! Any feathers awarded during the day will be available for you to see in your parent Arbor app so you too can also help our children connect positive actions with their beliefs and sense of self- satisfaction, 'You must feel so proud of showing how kind and thoughtful you are'.
