Attendance & Fines for Unauthorised Absence & Changes to the National Framework for Penalty Notices

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Office to improve our attendance and prevent children's attendance from falling below 95%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. We are contacting parents by letter if we are worried that a child's attendance is becoming close to 90%. Please be assured that this is just a process and that we are here to support families as much as we can to improve attendance.

If you intend to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a Leave of Absence Form and return this to the office. You should be aware that if your child is taken out of school and the reasons are not classed as exceptional, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. The school

must then inform the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice may be issued. Please note that letters confirming receipt of your Leave of Absence Request will only be issued if the Principal has been unable to authorise absences of 5 days or more.

The law requires all children between the ages of 5 and 16 to be in full time education. Under Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 it is the duty of the parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age to ensure that they attend school regularly.

A new National Framework for Penalty Notices came into force on 19th August 2024. As a result of these changes, absences will be tracked over a rolling 3 year period and penalty notices will be issued for the following:

- Term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days
- 10 sessions of unauthorised leave in a rolling 10 week period


Please note that penalty notices may also be issued before the threshold is met where it appears parents are deliberately avoiding the national threshold by taking several term time holidays of less than 5 days.

Penalty notices will continue to be issued per parent per child as follows:

- First Offence For term time leave or irregular school attendance; Charged at £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.
- Second Offence Where a second notice is issued within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either term time leave or irregular attendance, this will be charged at £160 if paid within 28 days.
- Third Offence If a third offence occurs within 3 years of the first penalty notice, a penalty notice will not be issued but the case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school', the Magistrate can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

Please be aware that these changes are national changes and all penalty notices will be issued by Cheshire East Council. The school does not benefit financially in any way from any fines issued.

If you have already submitted a Leave of Absence Request form for this academic year (2024/25), please be aware that you may receive an updated letter regarding the outcome due to these changes.



KS2 Snack

If you have children in years 3, 4, 5 & 6 and would like them to have snack this half term, please confirm consent and make payment via the *Trips* section on Arbor. Snack is charged at £5 per child for each half term.

- September 2024 onwards Educational and School Promotional Purposes
- Website and Social Media September 2024 onwards
- Local Area Visits September 2024 onwards

We also ask that that you complete the 2024/2025 Arbor Update to confirm that details we hold on Arbor are correct.

Asthma & Inhalers

If your child has been diagnosed with asthma or sometimes needs an inhaler, please ensure that there is an inhaler on site which is in date along with a completed Prescribed Medication Form for

the new academic year. We also ask that you confirm that the information we hold regarding your child's condition is up to date. If you have not yet completed new Asthma Forms for this academic year, we ask that you check the forms we have on file at the office and sign them to confirm the information is correct or complete new forms which are available from the office.

Please note that if we do not receive an update from you, we will assume that the current information we have is correct.

Medication

Please ensure that medication is not left in your child's bag. All medication must be passed directly to a member of staff. All medication must be in its original packaging and clearly named. A Prescribed or Non-Prescribed Medication Form must also be completed before any medication can be administered at school.

Children's Nasal Flu Vaccine

The Cheshire East School Age Immunisations Team will be visiting school on Monday 23rd September to administer the nasal flu vaccine to any children who have consent. A letter giving details of how parents can confirm their consent was sent out to all years (except Year 6 who will be at High School in September) before the summer. Please be aware that the online form used to confirm consent will close at **9am on Monday 9th September** and any children without consent will not be able to have the vaccination.
