RSE Parent Information Evening

Thank you to the parents who attended our RSHE Parent Information Evening this week. As discussed the parent questions asked during and after the session are here with the school responses.

Can I ask why some of the content or a recording of the meeting can not be shared publicly to parents?	This is due to copyright, Jigsaw does not permit the presentation to be recorded or re-published anywhere online, it is for in-school use only. We are however able to sent out the parent leaflet which was emailed to the whole
Will we be made aware when the topics will be covered so we can discuss/support at home?	school following the meeting. Teachers will incorporate this into their weekly learning poster so you are aware what is being discussed that week
Is puberty for girls and boys split?	No, the changes to our bodies is discussed for boys and girls
How does the curriculum support safety online, particularly regarding pornography?	Jigsaw has recognised the changing world in which we live and has included more lessons which support online safety and what to do when faced with images/videos that are not appropriate. This is an ongoing theme that runs through the whole curriculum and as with all of Jigsaw's topics, is dealt with in an age appropriate way. Online safety is also taught within the whole school and we know the importance of keeping our children safe in the real and virtual world.
Will there be any lessons/info on pronouns and gender at primary school level?	No, there are no direct teaching on this topic. Jigsaw talks about children and people as being of equal value, without labels, and considers the qualities most important in human beings

Following our successful open mornings for Reading we are holding another open morning this term regarding Maths. It has been great to hear how useful you have found these sessions but we recognise the difficulty of attending if you have more than one child within the school. After School Clubs Week Commencing 22nd April

Summer after school clubs start next week (week commencing 22nd April). These will run 12th July unless otherwise stated. All after school clubs will end at 4.15pm and children should be collected from the Junior Playground. **Please note that no after school clubs will run w/c 13th May due to SATs.**

Clubs run by staff members are free and only those booked directly through Sports Coaching Group or Cheshire Cricket Board are charged for.

Where places are limited, we operate on a 'first come, first served' basis. All clubs run by school staff are now live on Arbor. Additional clubs may now be booked where there is availability.

Attendance & Fines for Unauthorised Absence

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Office to improve our attendance and prevent children's attendance from falling below 95%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. We are contacting parents by letter if we are worried that a child's attendance is becoming close to 90%. Please be assured that this is just a process and that we are here to support families as much as we can to improve attendance.

If you intend to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a Leave of Absence Form and return this to the office. You should be aware that if your child is taken out of school and the reasons are not classed as exceptional, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. The school must then inform the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice may be issued if your child is absent for 5 days or more. Please note that letters confirming receipt of your Leave of Absence Request will only be issued if the Principal has been unable to authorise absences of 5 days or more.

We have to advise you that the Penalty Notice states that there is a Penalty to be paid of £60 per parent/carer per child to be paid within 21 days. If not paid within 21 days then the Penalty rises to £120 per parent/carer per child, up to the twenty eighth day. If full payment is not received by the twenty eighth day, then the Local Authority will prepare paperwork for a Prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

The law requires all children between the ages of 5 and 16 to be in full time education. Under Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 it is the duty of the parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age to ensure that they attend school regularly.
