In preparation for the disco, Friday 3rd November will be a Non-Uniform Day. Pupils may wear their own clothes or a spooky costume suitable for a day in school. Scary masks should not be worn and only appropriate accessories brought into school. Please note that accessories should be clearly named to avoid them getting lost.

Car Parking and Safety

Due to the building work, both staff car parks remain out of use for parents and visitors. For everyone's safety and to ensure there are no obstructions to the access road to the Brittles Pavilion, please ensure that you do not park on double yellow lines when using the pedestrian entrance to school. We have had a number of complaints about parents parking on the access road which can be very dangerous. We also ask that you take extra care and keep speed to a minimum when in close proximity to the school. Thank you for your kind cooperation.

Attendance & Fines for Unauthorised Absence

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Office to improve our attendance and prevent children's attendance from falling below 95%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. We are contacting parents by

letter if we are worried that a child's attendance is becoming close to 90%. Please be assured that this is just a process and that we are here to support families as much as we can to improve attendance.

If you intend to take your child out of school during term time, please complete a Leave of Absence Form and return this to the office. You should be aware that if your child is taken out of school and the reasons are not classed as exceptional, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. The school must then inform the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice may be issued if your child is absent for 5 days or more. Please note that letters confirming receipt of your Leave of Absence Request will only be issued if the Principal has been unable to authorise absences of 5 days or more.

We have to advise you that the Penalty Notice states that there is a Penalty to be paid of £60 per parent/carer per child to be paid within 21 days. If not paid within 21 days then the Penalty rises to £120 per parent/carer per child, up to the twenty eighth day. If full payment is not received by the twenty eighth day, then the Local Authority will prepare paperwork for a Prosecution in the Magistrates Court.

The law requires all children between the ages of 5 and 16 to be in full time education. Under Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 it is the duty of the parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age to ensure that they attend school regularly.
