# Should I keep my child off school?



## Yes

### Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

## Visual Assessments

Specsavers in Nantwich are now offering customers a visual stress testing service. Visual stress is a term used to describe visual discomfort and perceptual distortions in printed text that can be experienced by some children when reading.

Symptoms of visual stress can include:

- Words moving or appearing blurred.
- Eye strain or headaches when reading.
- Difficulty reading and writing.
- Light sensitivity.

Symptoms of visual stress can be alleviated or reduced using coloured overlays or precision tinted lenses, which also may help to improve reading performance and comfort. Research has shown that some children's reading ability, speed and comprehension can be improved by up to 25%. Coloured overlays and precision tints can make a great difference to youngsters in education, especially those who may already struggle with such conditions as dyslexia or other learning difficulties.

Migraine attacks in some people can also be linked to visual triggers, such as flickering lights. Precision tints selected with the use of an intuitive colorimeter can also help with this.

The visual stress testing service that Specsavers offer will follow the following recommended protocol:

1. Sight test.
2. Visual stress screening, involving an overlay assessment and a Wilkins Rate of Reading Test (resulting in use of an overlay)
3. Intuitive Colorimetry resulting in Precision Tinted Lenses.
