This week I would like to focus on road safety due to a couple of incidents involving both dangerous road use and dangerous pedestrian crossing reported this week. Please can I ask all parents driving in and around the school to drive slowly and be especially aware of children and families using the footpaths and pavements. The verges, kerbs and pavements are not areas to park or pull up onto, and doing so endangers our families who are walking there. Please encourage your children to walk on the side of the pavement furthest from the road whenever possible and always use either the designated crossing or a place where there is a clear view of oncoming traffic from both directions. While punctuality is important, I would much rather you arrived a little late but safely than put yourself or others in danger by rushing or crossing dangerously.

We will be talking to the children about road safety but would be grateful if you could echo this message and model both safe pedestrian and driving behaviours each day.
