What's New!

Reception & Year 6 Height and Weight Checks

The School Health Screening Team will be coming into school again one day during w/c 1st July to complete height and weight checks for children in Reception and Year 6 who were absent on 24th June. These checks will be done during the normal school day.

Medication

If your child requires medication whilst in school, please ensure that this is passed directly to class staff or to the office. Please do not leave medication in school bags. All medication should be in its original packaging and be clearly labelled with your child's name. A form must be completed for each medication to be administered.

Sun Safety

In sunny weather, please ensure your child has sun screen applied and brings a sun hat and water bottle to school with them. Please note that if sun cream is brought into school, this must not be shared with others due to potential allergies.



Changes to Attendance Policy and Penalty Notices

A new National Framework for Penalty Notices comes into force on 19th August 2024. As a result of these changes, absences will be tracked over a rolling 3 year period and penalty notices will be issued for the following:

- Term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days
- 10 sessions of unauthorised leave in a rolling 10 week period

Please note that penalty notices may also be issued before the threshold is met where it appears parents are deliberately avoiding the national threshold by taking several term time holidays of less than 5 days.

Penalty notices will continue to be issued per parent per child as follows:

- **First Offence** – For term time leave or irregular school attendance; Charged at £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.
- **Second Offence** – Where a second notice is issued within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either term time leave or irregular attendance, this will be charged at £160 if paid within 28 days.
- **Third Offence** – If a third offence occurs within 3 years of the first penalty notice, a penalty notice will not be issued but the case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school', the Magistrate can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

Please be aware that these changes are national changes and all penalty notices will be issued by Cheshire East Council. The school does not benefit financially in any way from any fines issued.

If you have already submitted a Leave of Absence Request form for the next academic year (2024/25), please be aware that you may receive an updated letter regarding the outcome when we return in September.
