Uniform Policy

It is our policy that all children should wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school event outside school hours. A complete list of the items needed for school uniform can be found below. Our policy is based on the notion that a school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- encourages a feeling of community and belonging
- is practical and smart
- •identifies the children with the school
- •is not distracting in class
- •does not act as a barrier to parents when choosing a school
- will meet the needs of individual pupils to accommodate their religion, ethnicity, disability or other special consideration

Full Uniform (required)

- Grey skirt, pinafore or grey trousers, or, when appropriate, a blue gingham summer dress
- White blouse or polo shirt
- V-neck sweatshirt or cardigan (preferably with school logo)
- Black shoes
- School tie (optional)
- Only studded earrings (No necklaces, rings or bracelets for safety)
- Long hair should be tied up, plaited or secured with a plain headband.

PE Kit (required)

PE kit should be worn for all PE and games lessons and sporting after school clubs. PE kit is worn to school on PE days and replaces the full uniform.

- House colour PE shirt (either a school kit, or a PLAIN t-shirt only)
- Plain navy blue/white shorts
- Plain Trainers, preferably black or white (for outdoor PE)
- Plain navy blue/black Tracksuit trousers or leggings
- House PE Sweatshirt or school jumper

Parents are asked to mark all clothing with their child's name.
