
Week Commencing 24th November will be WEEK 2 (New Autumn Menu) for lunches

We have introduced the option for parents to **pre-order school dinners via the Arbor portal/app**. By doing so, our kitchen team will have accurate numbers for each meal choice in advance, helping them prepare the correct portions for every lunch service. This will greatly reduce the likelihood of children being disappointed and will help us make lunchtimes smoother and more enjoyable for everyone. If parents do not pre-order via the app, children will still be able to give their lunch choice to the class teacher during the morning register.

Please continue to refer to the menu below as the Arbor app will list lunch options more generally as Main, Vegetarian Main, Jacket Potato/Sandwich or lunch from home. The menu will allow you to see the specific dishes available for each day so you can make the appropriate selection.

We encourage parents to look at the menu with their children before making selections to avoid any upset from pupils on the day. Selections made by parents will not be overwritten by teachers and we ask that you ensure your child knows that this is the meal that will be prepared for them. We are unable to change any lunch selections once they have been submitted to the kitchen.

To select your child's meals in advance online via the browser please visit **Arbor>Quick Actions>Meals>Autumn Term**. If using the Arbor App, please click the hamburger menu button (3 horizontal lines) and then **Meals-Term**. From here you can then select the week you would like to make the selection for and confirm this by clicking on **process**.

Lunchtime & After School Clubs – Spring Term

We are pleased to be offering various after school and lunch clubs for the Spring term. Our aim is that these clubs will enrich your child's learning and provide them with different experiences.

If your child wishes to attend any of the clubs below, please go to your child's Arbor account and choose the appropriate club for our child's year group. After signing up, children will be expected to attend **all** sessions (for safeguarding reasons we need to keep a register). The clubs in green are organised by Coach Barks and should be booked directly at <u>Coach Barks Spring Term Link</u>. The club in blue is organised by Crewe Alexandra in the Community and has to be booked directly with them via <u>www.crewealexandrainthecommunity.com</u>. The club in red is organised by Cheshire Cricket Board and has to be booked directly with them. Further details about the cricket club will follow as soon as possible.

All after school clubs will run weekly (term-time only) from the week beginning 12th January to the week ending 13th March unless otherwise stated below. All after school clubs will end at 4.15pm and children should be collected from the Junior Playground.

Clubs run by staff members are free and only those booked directly through external organisations are charged for.

Where places are limited, we will be operating on a 'first come, first served' basis. All clubs run by school staff will go live on Arbor from 4PM on SATURDAY 29th November. We

kindly ask that you initially book ONLY ONE free after-school club for your child to ensure that everyone has a fair opportunity to take part in the clubs. If there are still places available on Sunday 4th January, additional clubs may then be booked.

Please note that due to staff absences we may need to cancel clubs at short notice. We will, of course, do our utmost to avoid this and to help where we can.

Your Transport - Your Voice: Consultation until 7th December 2025

A consultation has launched on Cheshire East's draft Local Transport Plan (LTP) and Investment Framework. Their current LTP was adopted in 2019 and needs updating to reflect the considerable change in transport movements and trends. It is a statutory requirement to maintain a LTP to provide a policy framework that is robust and relevant to the needs of Cheshire East. Updating the LTP enables them to proactively feed in their strategic transport priorities to the future Combined Authority for Cheshire and Warrington.

The consultation seeks views on the proposed policies, investment framework, and key investment packages, which will guide how they plan, prioritise, and deliver transport improvements in the future. Following the consultation, the LTP will be updated and adopted in 2026.

Cheshire East look forward to receiving feedback from residents, businesses and communities which will help shape the final versions of the LTP.

 Preparing for Adulthood


