#### Sharing of Information on Social Media

#### After School Clubs

There will be no after school clubs during the first half term when we return in September to give everyone time to settle back into school. Swan Stars will run as normal.

#### Y1 Drop Off & Collection

In order to reduce congestion and ensure the safety of children, we kindly ask that parents/carers do not walk up the ramp when dropping off and collecting from Year 1. Thank you for your kind cooperation.

#### Y6 Parent Information meeting for London Residential

There will be an information meeting at 3.30pm on 16th September for the parents of children attending the London residential. This will be held in Miss Smith's classroom. The

presentation will be added to the Y6 class page on the school website for anyone who is unable to attend.

#### Lunch Payments & KS2 Snack

If you have children in years 3, 4, 5 & 6, and would like them to have snack each half term, you will need to confirm consent and make payment via the *Trips* section on Arbor. Snack is charged at £5.50 per child for each half term. KS2 Snack for this half term shows as *KS2 Snack Autumn 1 2025*.

Lunches are charged at £2.58 per day for both Cygnets and KS2 children, payable in advance under *Meals* on Arbor. Reception, year 1 & 2 meals are free of charge as these are fully funded.

When topping up meal accounts, please be mindful that we are unable to refund any balances remaining at the end of the school year. *All meal payments should be made in advance*.

We kindly ask that parents check lunch accounts weekly and make the office aware of any queries by end of play on Friday at the latest.

#### Arbor Information & Consents

To ensure school has up-to-date contact information in case of an emergency, please check your child's Arbor account and inform school immediately by email of any changes or errors. Please also ensure that all consents (e.g. Local Area Visits, photographs, walking home, mobile phones, etc) are up to date and contact the school office if you have any issues. Thank you.

#### **Pupils Prescribed Inhalers**

If your child has been prescribed an inhaler and you have not already done so, please complete new asthma forms for this academic year and ensure that your child has an inhaler (and completed Prescribed Medication Form) in school. Paper copies of the forms are available from the school office.

#### Swan Stars Bookings for Academic Year 2025-2026

Bookings for contracted sessions can be requested on KidsClubHQ. These will be allocated on a first come, first served basis depending on availability. Payment for contracted sessions is by monthly invoice to be paid before 1st of each month. Current contracts will carry over unless we are informed otherwise.

Bookings for ad-hoc sessions are also available to book subject to availability. Please note that payment for all ad-hoc bookings is due at the time of booking however far in advance. If payment is not made, bookings will unfortunately be cancelled on the system.

Please note that to cancel any bookings 4 weeks notice is required for contracted sessions and 7 days notice is required for ad-hoc bookings. Any sessions cancelled inside the notice period will still be chargeable in full.

Please note that payments made by BACs and Tax Free Childcare can take up to 10 working days (or longer during school holidays) to show on accounts.

#### Attendance & Fines for Unauthorised Absence

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Office to improve our attendance and prevent children's attendance from falling below 95%. Children with attendance below 90% are classed as persistent absentees. We are contacting parents by letter if we are worried that a child's attendance is becoming close to 90%. Please be assured that this is just a process and that we are here to support families as much as we can to improve attendance.

If your child is going to be absent due to a medical appointment, please inform the school office and show confirmation of the appointment (This can be by letter, text, appointment card or email).

If your child is going to be absent due to illness, please inform the school office and give as much detail as possible regarding their symptoms/diagnosis for their attendance records.

If your child is going to be absent for any other reason (e.g. holiday, wedding, non-medical appointment), please complete a Leave of Absence Request Form at your earliest possible opportunity and attach any relevant supporting information that you wish to be taken into consideration. You should be aware that if your child is taken out of school and the reasons are not classed as exceptional, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised. **Any appeal should be made prior to the end of the period of absence before an FPN is issued.** 

The law requires all children between the ages of 5 and 16 to be in full time education. Under Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 it is the duty of the parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age to ensure that they attend school regularly.

A new National Framework for Penalty Notices came into force on 19th August 2024. As a result of these changes, absences will be tracked over a rolling 3 year period and penalty notices will be issued for the following:

Term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days

10 sessions of unauthorised leave in a rolling 10 week period

Please note that penalty notices may also be issued before the threshold is met where it appears parents are deliberately avoiding the national threshold by taking several term time holidays of less than 5 days.


Penalty notices will continue to be issued per parent per child as follows:

- First Offence For term time leave or irregular school attendance; Charged at £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days, reducing to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.
- Second Offence Where a second notice is issued within 3 years of the first penalty notice for either term time leave or irregular attendance, this will be charged at £160 if paid within 28 days.
- Third Offence If a third offence occurs within 3 years of the first penalty notice, a penalty notice will not be issued but the case may proceed to Parental Prosecution under the Single Justice Procedure. If found guilty of the offence of 'Failure to send a child to school', the Magistrate can impose a fine up to £1000 or legal proceedings under Section 444 (1a) can include a fine of up to £2500.

Please be aware that these changes are national changes and all penalty notices will be issued by Cheshire East Council. The school does not benefit financially in any way from any fines issued.


