Parking

To ensure the safety of all, please be considerate to both local residents and businesses when parking close to school for drop-offs and collection. Please be aware that the car park at the back of the shops is a private car park intended for shop users only.

If using the school car park, we kindly ask that cars are only parked in marked bays so that they do not cause an obstruction. We also ask that cars are not left running whilst dropping off or collecting pupils.

To help ease parking for upcoming year group assemblies, we will open the front car park for parent use at 2:15pm on the days of the assemblies. Please be aware that spaces are limited and quite tight so we advise that the area is only suitable for small vehicles. We ask that parents try to avoid queuing for the car park/blocking the driveway. Please also note that anyone using the car park does so at their own risk.

Your ongoing cooperation is much appreciated.

Changes to Free School Meal Eligibility

From the start of the 2026 to 2027 academic year, FSM eligibility is expanding to include to all children from households in receipt of Universal Credit regardless of household earnings. Free school meals are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

A pupil is only eligible to receive a free school meal where both:

- a claim for this support has been made by parents (Please contact Cheshire East to do this)
- their eligibility has been verified by the school where they are enrolled or by the local authority

Households may also be entitled to a meal if they:

- are in receipt of income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- receive the guarantee element of Pension Credit
- meet criteria set out in separate guidance for families with no recourse to public funds.

Please note that universal funding will continue for pupils in Reception and KS1 (Years 1 & 2).

Best Start Family Hub launch new 'What's On' Guide

Cheshire East have developed an improved online 'What's On' guide, designed to make it easier for families and professionals to find activities and support in their local area. The updated platform includes enhanced search functionality, allowing users to filter events by age, postcode and keywords, alongside consistent branding to improve accessibility and user experience.

Through their Family Hubs, they offer a broad and inclusive programme of services for babies, children, young people and their families. This includes regular sessions such as stay and play, sensory activities and early development groups, alongside antenatal support, breastfeeding guidance and practical advice for parents and carers to help give children the best possible start in life.

They also provide targeted support for those with additional or specific needs, including services for children and young people with SEND, groups for young carers and care leavers, and safe, inclusive spaces for LGBTQ+ young people. These tailored services offer advice, emotional support and opportunities to build confidence, develop life skills and connect with peers.

In addition, families can access a wide range of wider support through their hubs, including professional advice via drop-in sessions, educational psychology and speech and language input, financial wellbeing guidance and information about becoming a childminder. All of the sessions are free, informal and available without booking, ensuring families can access the right help at the right time in a welcoming and supportive environment.

PageTicker

As we introduce PageTicker, we are asking parents and carers to help us set up the system by scanning the barcodes of any books sent home with their child and adding them to their bookshelf within the app. When recording reading sessions, please take a moment to share your observations about how your child has read. For example, did they read fluently and at an appropriate pace? Did they use expression and show understanding of the text? Were there any words, phrases or sections that they found difficult or did not fully understand? These comments provide valuable information for staff and help us support your child's reading development. Once you begin using the app, you will notice a comments section; however, please be aware that this should only be used for comments relating to the book being read and your child's reading experience. It is not intended as a method of communication with the class teacher, and any general queries or messages should continue to be directed through emails for the attention of the staff.

We appreciate your support as we launch PageTicker and are confident that it will become a valuable tool in helping every child develop a lifelong love of reading.

Swan Stars Payments & Bookings

We kindly ask that all Swan Stars payments are paid in advance of sessions being taken. Ad hoc sessions are due at the time of booking however far in advance this may be.
