Highly Motivated Student	<ul> <li>Highly motivated and disciplined. Is able to focus on learning for extended period of time.</li> <li>Resilient: enjoys a challenge and is not put off when learning becomes difficult.</li> <li>Independent: Is able to undertake their work without close supervision.</li> <li>High levels of initiative and curiosity: has a thirst for knowledge and will undertake wider research and reading.</li> <li>Accuracy of work: always proof reads their work and edits it before submitting it.</li> <li>Always acts on feedback and looks to improve their work.</li> <li>Clear love of learning.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Homework represents         the very best that the         student can do and         often demonstrates         extension of the task         from the lesson.</li> <li>The student always         proof reads their work         and edits it before         submitting.</li> </ul>	1
Engaged Student	<ul> <li>Work is completed with accuracy and pride, it is proof read and edited before it is submitted. This is the students 'best work'.</li> <li>Works hard in class and is engaged with their learning.</li> <li>Makes a positive contribution to group activities and class discussions.</li> <li>Demonstrates enthusiasm and curiosity in their learning: will ask intelligent questions and make the effort to read around the subject.</li> <li>Has a positive attitude in class.</li> <li>Always acts on feedback and looks to improve their work.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Homework represents the students 'best work' and is handed in on time.</li> <li>Homework is proofread before being submitted.</li> <li>Revision in undertaken and learning is evident.</li> </ul>	2
Passive Student	<ul> <li>Work is completed but it does not consistently represent the students 'best work'.</li> <li>Usually on task but effort varies from acceptable to good.</li> <li>May coast during group activities and allow others to complete work/tasks.</li> <li>Rarely asks questions and is reluctant to answer questions set by the teacher.</li> <li>Has low levels of enthusiasm and curiosity for the subject being studied.</li> <li>Behaviour is compliant.</li> <li>Will respond to feedback but it lacks depth and detail.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Homework is usually completed, but often this does not represent the students 'best work'.</li> <li>Revision does not have a major impact on learning.</li> </ul>	3
Disengaged Student	<ul> <li>Work is often incomplete.</li> <li>Effort is generally poor. Likely to be off task unless closely supervised in lesson.</li> <li>Makes little or no contribution to group activities.</li> <li>Never asks questions and chooses not to answer questions set by the teacher unless targeted for a response.</li> <li>Behaviour is likely to be poor.</li> <li>Rarely acts on feedback given about their work.</li> <li>Is easily distracted and may distract others from their learning.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Homework is often incomplete or not attempted at all.</li> <li>There is little effort demonstrated in any homework task,</li> <li>Never or rarely revises.</li> </ul>	4
