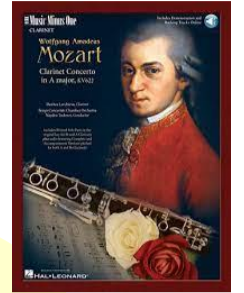


# Music Learning Journey

This term, you'll build on your knowledge of correct keyboard technique and become an even more confident performer.

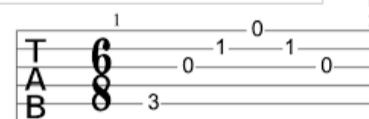


## Film Music
