'Peace makers' poster. Each child who enters receives a House Point and one per House will be chosen to put on display. Please ensure children name their posters and bring them in next week!





Achieve: we have nurtured a love of music and unity, and achieved performances we parents, staff, and volunteers who supportceed in demonstrating the very best of our



#### Chestnut class Egyptian workshop

We were delighted by the enthusiasm and creativity of our Chestnut Class in this term's Egyptian workshop. The children immersed themselves in the world of the pharaohs: they decoded hieroglyphics, explored the process of mummification and even designed their own scarab beetles.

This hands-on experience did much more than entertain — it deepened understanding, spurred curiosity, and helped the children see history as a dynamic investigation. Working together, they posed questions, tested ideas, and reflected on how ancient practices compare to modern ones.
