





Sticky Knowledge about explorers?

- During his early years in navigation, Columbus participated in a number of voyages to Africa, giving him a lot of knowledge and experience about sailing in the Atlantic.
- Rather than using the stars, on this voyage Columbus had a compass and a traverse board to track where the fleet was going.
- Christopher Columbus was named 'Admiral of the Seven Seas' due to his triumphs.
- Captain Robert Falcon Scott CVO was a Royal Navy officer and explorer who led two expeditions to the Antarctic regions.
- Binton Church has a memorial stain glass window to Captain Scott.
