

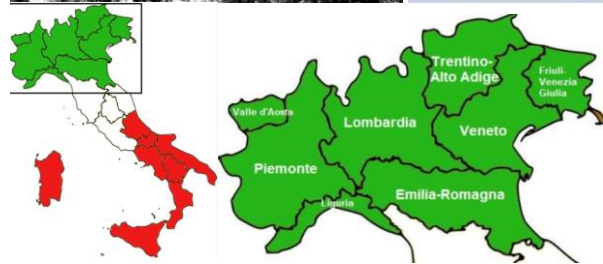
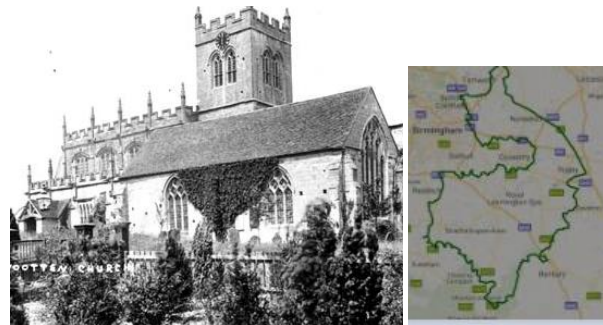
Chestnut: Location, Location, Location Knowledge Mat

continent	A large continuous mass of land made up of different countries
county	A county is an area within a country which runs services such as transport, education, policing, waste management, etc.
region	Larger areas of the country which have similar characteristics but don't always have a set boundary
spatial patterns	show how data is different across an area
climate	The usual weather conditions in a place
human geography	How human activity affects the earth
physical characteristics	Natural features like rivers, mountains, forests, seas
urban	Belonging to, or relating to, a town or city
rural	Areas of countryside
four-figure grid reference	Four numbered reference that helps locate a feature on a map.
spatial patterns	show how data is different across an area.
census	a collection of data about a whole population.
