How far can you travel?



Imagine that you are a Viking explorer...We know that some of your books are longer so instead of saying every book read, we are going to say that for every 4 chapters you read, you can 'sail to' another country. If you don't have a book with chapters, you can count roughly 14 pages as the equivalent of a chapter.
