Trade

The buying and selling of goods or services.

Import

The action of bringing goods or services into a country.

Export

The action of sending good to services to another country.

Fairtrade

Trade between developed countries and producers in developing countries (where a 'fair' price has been agreed).

Raw material

The basic material that a product is made from.

Multinational

Involving several countries.

Goods

Items that can be bought or sold.

Services

Roles or tasks that people can do in exchange for money.

Can you identify why some countries import certain goods and why they export certain goods?
