LET'S GET WORDY!

INVADER

'Invaders' enter a country by force with the intention of conquering it. Invaders may take land, treasure, and people as slaves, and they may also kill and injure people and destroy their homes, crops and livelihoods.

SETTLER

'Settlers' move into a new area peacefully and make their homes there. Settlers may build houses, plant crops, rear animals and create communities. An army may invade a country and then more people from their country may follow and settle on the land. Some of the invading soldiers may stay and settle too.

Saxons

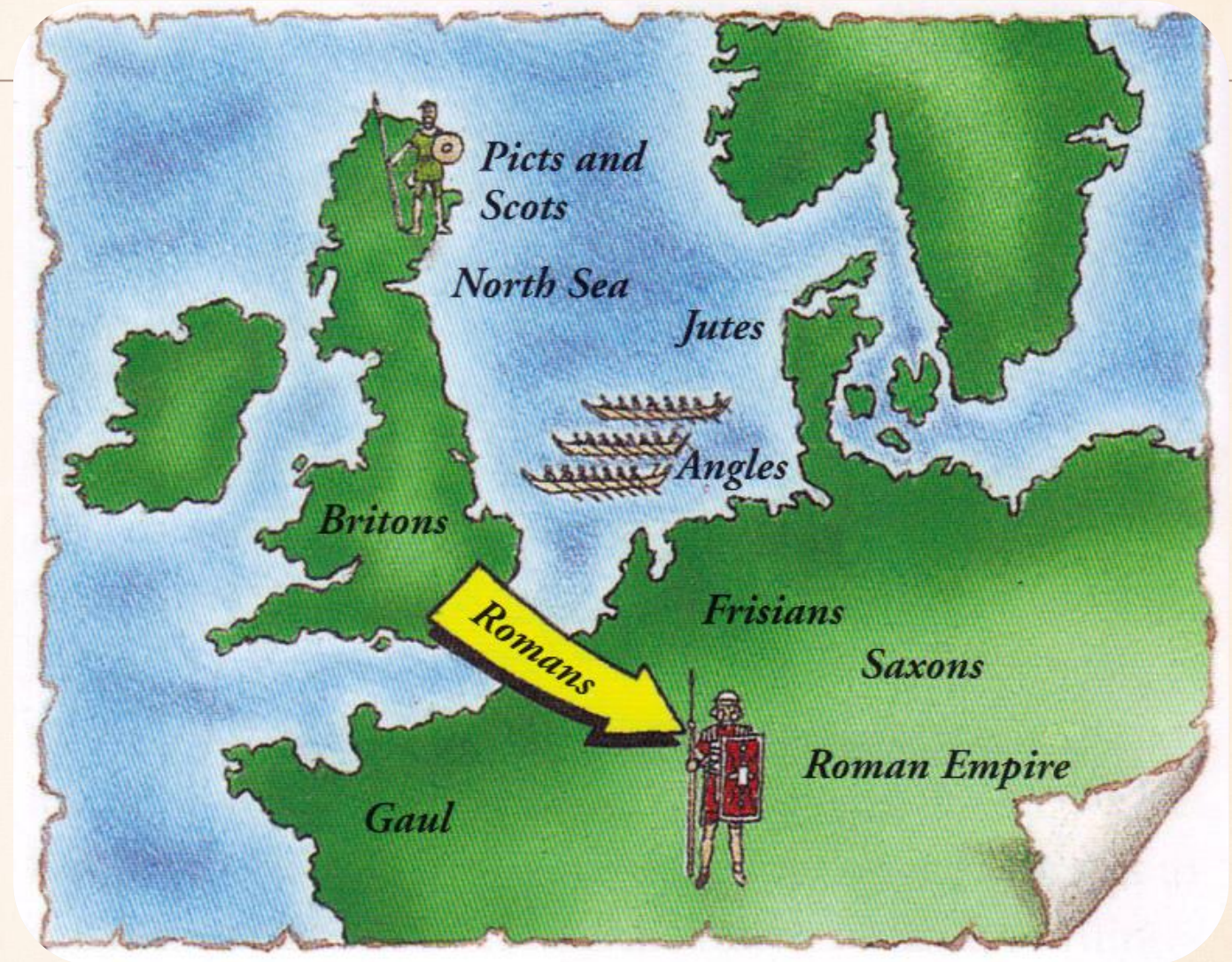
The Angles and the Saxon tribes were the largest of the three attacking tribes and so we often know them as Anglo-Saxons.

ANGLO- SAXON SETTLERS

In AD 407 British chiefs asked the Anglo-Saxons soldiers to come from Germany and fight against the Picts and the Scots.

In return for this help the Anglo-Saxons were given land. The Anglo-Saxons were strong soldiers. They had defeated the Picts and the Scots and,



when they were asked to leave, they refused to go. As time passed, more and more Anglo-Saxons arrived, wanting land and attacking the Britons. Soon they began to settle in Britain.

The Anglo-Saxons came from Denmark, Germany and the Netherlands.

These fearsome warriors rowed across the North Sea in wooden boats to England and forced the tribes in Britain to flee their homes.

Within a few centuries, the land they had invaded was known as England, after the Angles.



HOW DID THEY INVADE?

Believe it or not, the Anglo-Saxons were warrior-farmers. They began to invade Britain while the [Romans](#) were still in control.

They wanted control and land.

The Anglo-Saxons were tall, fair-haired men, armed with swords and spears and round shields.

Their other skills consisted of hunting, farming, textile (cloth) production and leather working.



HOW DID THEY INVADE?

In the 4th century AD the Anglo Saxons attempted to invade Britain but were beaten by the Romans.



However, after the Romans left Britain at the start of the fifth century they invaded again and the British were not trained well enough to defend themselves.



The Anglo-Saxons came from Denmark, Germany and the Netherlands.

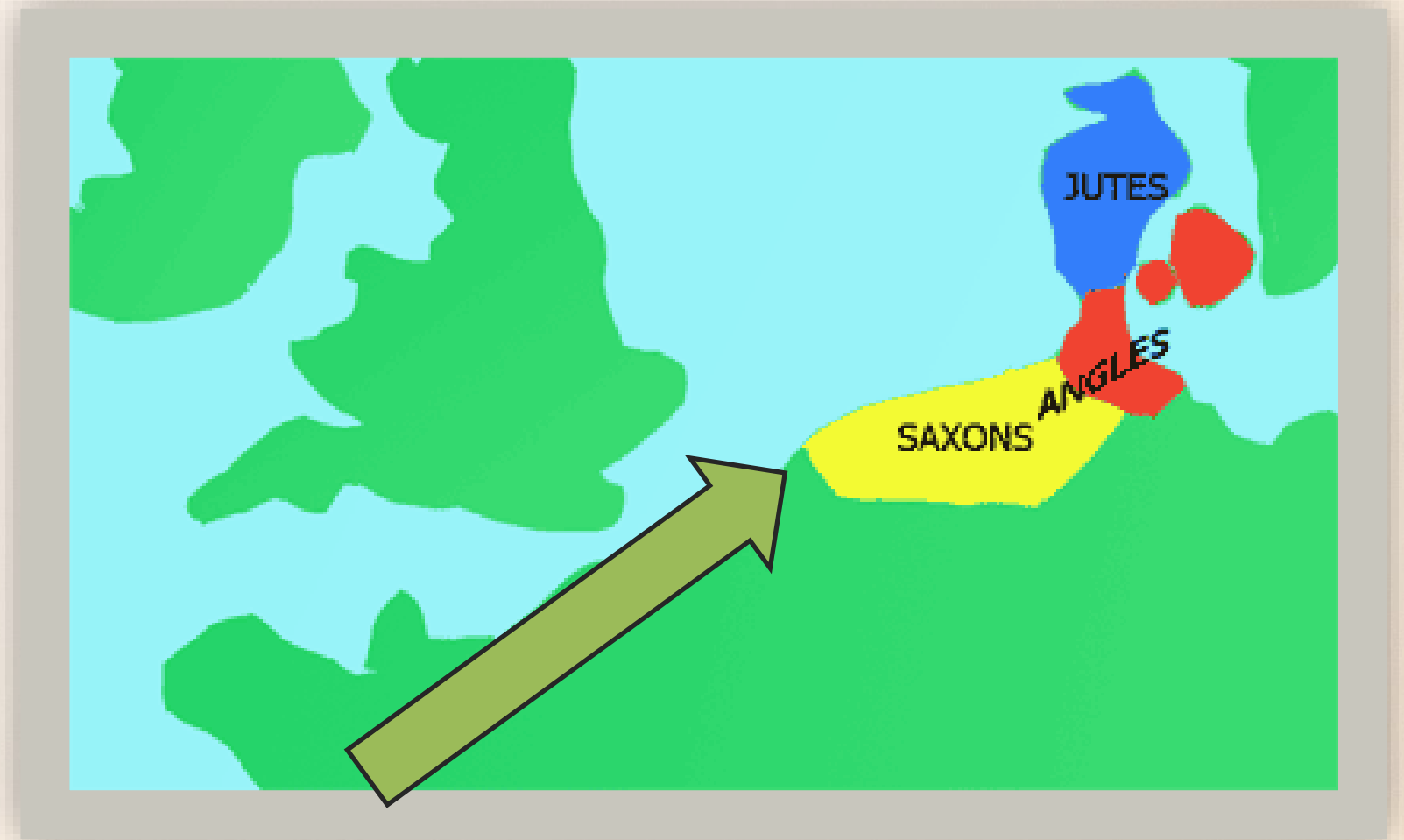
