Traditional Tale	A story that has been retold over many years. Sometimes called a fairy-tale. 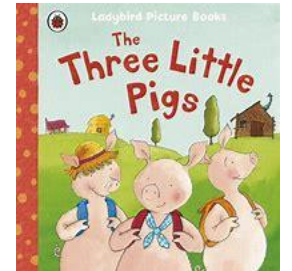


### Fairy-tale Ideas
