- This video didn't cause any loss of money or cause pain, but not all fake news is innocent.

With faster adoption, its harder and harder to check the authenticity of the new digital products. This has allowed scammers to create fake products or news to hurt people financially.

#### HOW FAKE NEWS CAN HURT – HEART DISEASE

- The president took notice of the rising deaths of heart disease in his county when he himself suffered with the condition.
- Popular scientists at the time endorsed reducing fat in people's diet, which sounded right.
- The real results showed that people were eating too much **sugar.**
- The sugar companies often paid scientists to shift the blame to fat.

#### YEO VALLEY'S 0% FAT VANILLA YOGURT HAS 81 CALORIES - JUST ONE LESS



Almost three times the amount of sugar (14g)

## FAKE PHONE

THIS FAKE PHONE ONLY HAS ONE CAMERA WHILE BEING SOLD AS A TRIPLE CAMERA.

THIS HURTS YOU FINANCIALLY BECAUSE YOU ARE PAYING FOR SOMETHING THAT IS NOT REAL.

#### **FAKE APPS**

- This app tries to trick you into spending \$100 on the app repeatedly.
- It uses the fingerprint scanner.
- The fake news is it pretended to scan your finger to give you a fitness report.
- This hurts you financially



## FAKE APPS 2

- This app tries to access parts of your phone.
- Why would a calculator need to make phone calls.
- You would probably end up with a high phone bill.
- Be careful when apps ask for permission. Think "does this app need this?"



#### Example

Pokémon Go - Needs your location to work **Instagram -** Needs access to your camera to work. Calculator would not need access to any files, photos, phone calls or location.

## CONCLUSION

- Some information that is presented as fact, might be paid for by someone or a company.
- Some information might be someone's wrong opinion but presented as 100% factual.
- Fake news can mislead you. It can cause you financial and physical harm.
- Double check news that would have a big impact on your life to make sure it is true.
- Only use official websites for information and be carful of scams that use official logos.
