	Maths Activities	English Activities	Creative Activities
Monday	<p>Warm Up Activity: Order 5 numbers from 1-20. Which number comes first? Can you order the numbers from smallest to largest?</p> <p>Main Activity: Think about your new daily routine- Wake up, complete Joe Wicks PE, eat breakfast, complete Math activity, complete English activity, have dinner etc. Draw a timeline of the day – children to describe using language such as first, morning, afternoon, evening, after that. Please take some photos & upload this to the Class Dojo portfolio</p>	<p>Phonics Activity: Play flashcards Speed Trial – Phase 3 on the Phonics Play website</p> <p>Main Activity: What would you pack in the basket if you were little Red Riding Hood? Write a list of things that you would take – remember to start each item on a new line and start with a capital letter.</p>	<p>Make a strong basket for Little Red Riding Hood to take the food to Grandma's – what will you make the basket out of?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Warm Up Activity: Count forwards and backwards from 20</p> <p>Main Activity: Use a timer on your phone/tablet. Think of different activities. Filling a cup with water, running 4 lengths of the garden, reading a book etc. Discuss why things take longer than others. Order the different activities you completed from the shortest time to longest.</p>	<p>Phonics Activity: Play Picnic on Pluto – Phase 3 on the Phonics Play website – the children can choose a sound to revise</p> <p>Main Activity: Draw and label a map to show Little Red Riding Hood how to get to Grandma's house – you might want to write a set of instructions to tell her how to get there.</p>	<p>Should Little Red Riding Hood have spoken to the Wolf – What do you think she should have done?</p>
Wednesday	<p>Warm Up Activity: 1 more and 1 less – numbers to 20. Show children a written number, children are to choose the number that is 1 more/ 1 less than the given number.</p> <p>Main Activity: Discuss the different times on a clock – focus on o'clock, half past and quarter past. Remember the hands on a clock are different sizes, the long hand tells us the minutes and the short hand reads the hours. Complete the 'Telling the time' worksheet – read the clock faces and write down the correct times.</p>	<p>Phonics Activity: Play Tricky Keyword Trucks – phase 3 on the Phonics Play website</p> <p>Main Activity: Create a Wanted poster for the Wolf – Can you write a description of what he looks like?</p>	<p>Little Red Riding Hood would like a new cape to go to Grandma's house but it is raining – can you make her a cape that is waterproof – can you find out which materials are waterproof and which are not?</p> <p>Please take some photos & upload this to the Class Dojo portfolio</p>
Thursday	<p>Warm Up Activity: How many different ways can you represent the number 5. Draw 5 fingers, the number 5 Numicon plate, 5 on a dice etc.</p> <p>Main Activity: Sing Months of the Year song - https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Fe9bnYRzFvk Write the months of the year on strips of paper, can you order the months?</p>	<p>Phonics Activity: Practice forming the letters i, j, k, l – try to sit your letters on the line and form them the correct way round – can you write the capital letter for each one?</p> <p>Main Activity: Write a letter to Grandma from the Wolf – What do you think he might say?</p>	<p>Choose one of the Little Red Riding Hood songs on Twinkl – can you make up your own actions?</p>

Friday	<p>Warm Up Activity: Watch Shapes are everywhere clip https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OEbRDtCAFdU</p> <p>What shapes can you identify in your house/garden?</p> <p>Main Activity: Complete the 1 minute Challenge. Use the challenge cards to complete the different activities – note down how many of each challenge you completed in 1 minute (use a timer on your phone/tablet). Which activity did you find the easiest, why? Which activity was the hardest, why?
