Wednesday - Page 14-18

Boxing Up is a new type of plan. Read the information. MC = Main Character Barrier = a problem

Read the two Model plans - Hugging close = similar to the model Shaking hands = your own idea Use the planning sheet supplied to construct your plan.

<u>Thursday – Write your story</u>

Write paragraph 1 and 2.

- Paragraph 1 Introduce your main character and show that he/she is poor. Give details about their daily life using <u>fronted adverbials</u>.
- Check punctuation and spelling
- Paragraph 2 introduce the new character who is 'helped' in some way by the MC.
- Describe the new character in detail
- Check punctuation and spelling.

Friday - Write paragraph 3 to 5.

- Look at your plan again and re-read your story so far.
- Grant the main character a wish. Look at the ideas in the workbook.
- Make sure your character thinks about what her family and friends need. Look at the ideas on the workbook.
- Final paragraph make the wish come true and make sure your reader knows how the main character has changed because of the wish see the example in the work book.

Li is a poor fisherman.	MC is poor	
Li catches the King of the fishes but chooses to put it back	MC rescues an animal that is the King or Queen of its kind.	
The King of the Fishes grants Li 1 wish.	The animal grants the MC one wish.	
Li asks each member of his family what they would wish for. He struggles to decide.	The MC struggles to decide what to wish for.	
Li combines three wishes into one and asks the King of the Fishes for his wish.	The MC chooses his wish, asks the creature and his wish is granted.
