1. Ed has nine boxes of eggs. Each box had 39 eggs. How many eggs did Ed have in total?
2. Mandy ate seven chocolate cakes. Each cake had 182 slices. How many slices did Mandy eat in total?
3. Hannah bought three puppies on each day 12 weeks. How many puppies did she buy altogether?
4. Dave is baking 9 cakes. He needs 783g of butter for one cake. How much butter does he need in total?
