We have just received this message from **Tees Community Dental Service** – we will be undertaking the National Dental Sample Survey of 5-Year-old children on Teesside over the coming months. We will be in contact with your school next week to arrange a convenient date and time for our dentist and dental nurse to come into the school to conduct the survey. We will provide more information when we have it.

FAO parents with children in Y1 – message from the DfE:

Notification for Yarm Primary School: One or more pupils in year one have been selected to take part in the DfE Five to Twelve study

Five to Twelve is a national study of around 8,000 children and their families attending primary school in the 2020s. By following children over time, the study aims to provide new evidence about how children's environments and experiences impact on their education and wellbeing in the post-pandemic period. The study will collect data about the child, their family and school.

For the first stage of the study, the research contractor (NatCen) will be sending letters to the parents or guardians of the selected children at their home address in Nov/Dec 2023. The information posted to families will list the ways they can get in touch with the study team should they have questions about participating or opting out.

Understandably, families may contact your school to verify the legitimacy of the research. If so, then we ask that you provide reassurance that this is an official DfE study.

Thank you for your support in the recent **Children in Need** fund raiser – your generosity means that £357 will be sent to the charity shortly. Thank you to Y3 for leading on this.

We were contacted by Dame Rachel De Souza, Children's Commissioner for England – who has launched a campaign called **The Big Ambition**.
