

### More About Suffixes

-

The suffix -ation can be added to verbs to make nouns. Like this: **inform + ation = information**.

- **1.** Make nouns from these verbs, using the suffix -ation. Remember you may have to follow some spelling rules.
  - Rule 1: When a word ends in a 'y', change to 'i' before the suffix -ation is added.
  - Rule 2: The silent 'e' at the end of a root word is dropped before adding -ation.
  - Rule 3: If the root word ends in 'ate', drop the 'ate' when -ation is added.


