## What is a timeline?

We use timelines to put events in the order that they happen.

We call this chronological order.

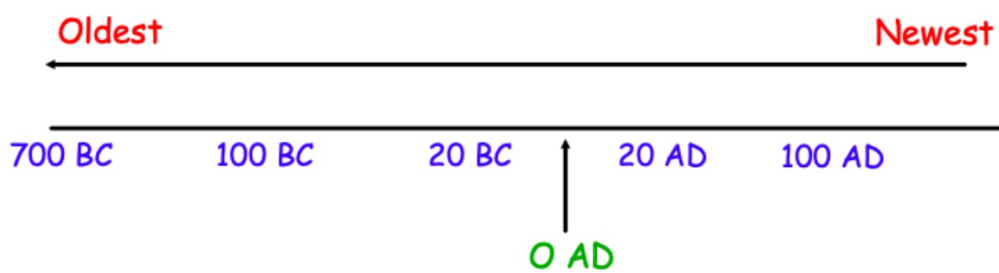
We arrange our dates from when Jesus was born in the year 0

BC means Before Jesus was born

AD comes from the Latin *Anno Domini* and means After Jesus was born

\*The larger the BC number, the older it is (longer ago in the past.)

\*The smaller the BC number, the newer it is.

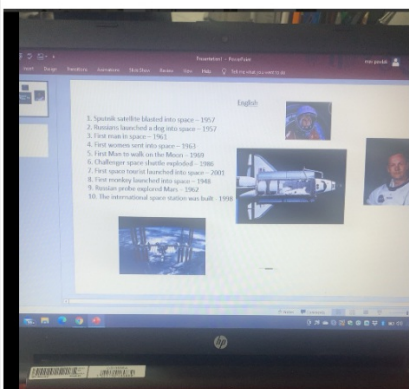


Your task today is to create a timeline with the Romans on and other key periods of History that you have learnt about.

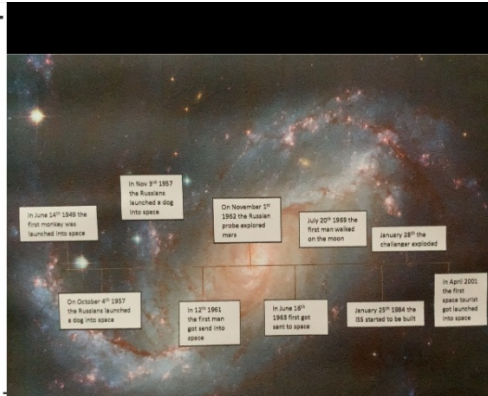

Thanks Austin! I like the different way in which you have presented your timeline. Perhaps you could now research one of these facts further or have a look for your own fact to add to this timeline.

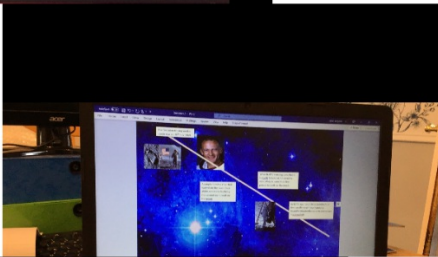

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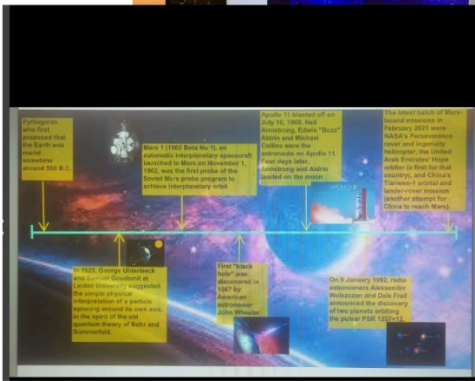

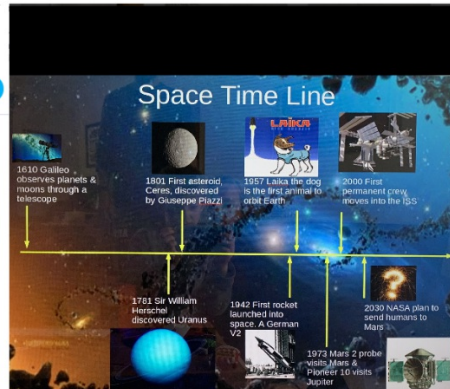
