What is a timeline?

We use timelines to put events in the order that they happen.

We call this chronological order.

We arrange our dates from when Jesus was born in the year 0

BC means Before Jesus was born

AD comes from the Latin *Anno Domini* and means After Jesus was born

*The larger the BC number, the older it is (longer ago in the past.)

*The smaller the BC number, the newer it is.
