Follow the slides in the <b>'Subjunctive Form'</b> pdf. Using this information answer the questions from the <b>'Subjunctive form questions pdf'</b>.</p> <p>Computing</p> <p>Read through the <b>Fake Emails and Scams</b> pdf and record why you think the email is a scam (the challenge from the slides). Then complete the activities in the 'Tower of Treasure' from the link below.</p>
