Use simple punctuation e.g. capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Recognise and represent numbers to 10 in different ways.

Explore numbers to 10 using different combinations and objects.

Identify the four basic shapes circle, square, rectangle and triangle and know and their features.

Mathematical language such as big/small, more/less, tall/short and heavy/light, including further technical vocabulary e.g. big, bigger, biggest.

Add two single digit numbers together.

Recall my number bonds to 5 and the inverse bonds.

Recall some number bonds to 10

Recite numbers to 20 and beyond.

Subitise within numbers to 10.

Catch and throw a ball over and under arm.

Hold and use scissors precisely e.g following a simple pattern.

Run for a sutained period of time – e.g. the daily mile

Hold and use a pencil correctly.

Manage my own risk taking independdetly and confidently – jump and land safely from an appropriate height.

Develop my own spacial awareness to naviagate people and objects.
