Think really carefully about the questions and remember our work in Guided Reading in school: ~Look for any key words in the questions ~Read the text again and underline the key words from the questions.</p> <p>This should help you find the answers.</p> <p>Remember to write in full sentences.</p> <p>Daily Reading (15 minutes)</p>	<p>Today is a quiz!!</p> <p>Today we will revisit adding suffixes to words.</p> <p>Follow your way through the PowerPoint which revisits some of the different rules we have learnt for when we add a suffix to a word.</p> <p><b>Once you have practised on the PowerPoint, your task is to complete the worksheet.</b></p>	<p>Work through the PowerPoint: Topic Lesson 5.3.21. What was life like in Ancient Egypt?</p> <p>This will help you to understand what was important to people during ancient Egyptian times.</p> <p>You will also: -Focus on using pictures to find out information. -Raise questions about Egyptian Life and the River Nile. -Explain why the River Nile was essential for survival. -Compare modern life with life in ancient Egypt.</p> <p>Task 1: Read the Topic 5.3.21. Resource sheet 'River Nile Fact sheet'.</p>

How many different ways can you do it?</p>			<p>Task 2: Complete the Topic Activity 5.3.21 'Ancient Egyptian Timeline.'</p> <p>Cut out the pictures and use the dates to help you put the events in chronological order, beginning with the earliest date.</p> <p>(Tip: The higher the number of years B.C., the longer ago the event took place).</p> <p>Can you find Egypt and the River Nile on a world map?</p>
