<b>difference</b>	A point or way in which people or things are not the same.	For the following half term, our PSHCE topic will be around similarities and differences. We will explore what everyone has in common and what makes everyone unique.	There are many things that make us special, such as our talents, qualities, likes and dislikes.
<b>similarity</b>	The state or fact of being similar.		
<b>special</b>	Someone or something that is distinctive or different from others.		
<b>unique</b>	Being the only one of its kind; unlike anything else.		We are all unique and special in our own way.
<b>emotions</b>	Emotions are also called feelings - you know, like being happy, mad or scared.		There is a range of different emotions (e.g. happiness, sadness, anger, fear, surprise, nervousness).
<b>feelings</b>	An emotional state or reaction.		
<b>respect</b>	Admiring or looking up to someone because that person has done something extraordinary.		
<b>preferences</b>	A greater liking for one alternative over another or others.		
<b>talents</b>	A natural ability to be good at something.		
<b>personality</b>	The combination of characteristics or qualities that form an individual's distinctive character.
