It uses particular sounds and notes to give it an Egyptian flavour.


The melody comes from a scale of these notes

The symbol # means sharp. On a keyboard they are all the black keys

G# Sharp is to the right of G

Can you find G and G# on this picture below?



The sounds used are from traditional musical instruments such as the Egyptian flute.
