Theme: *Similarities and Differences*

Enquiry Question: In what ways are we 'similar' and how are we 'different' from each other?

Different	Not the same as another or each other
Equal	Someone or something that is the same in amount or importance.
Respect	A feeling of admiring somebody or something that is good or important.
Community	A group of people living in the same place or having a characteristic in common.
Values	Principles or standards of behaviour.
Diversity	A range of different things, a mixture or an assortment.
Customs	A practice common to many people or to a particular place.
Feelings	An emotional state or reaction.

For this half term, our PSHCE topic will be focused on valuing and respecting one another.




Children will learn the importance of respecting others, even when others are different, make different choices or have different preferences.

They will learn the importance of self respect and how this links to their own happiness. They will focus on different people who make up a school community, what they share and what links them. Children will be made aware of how it feels when people do not feel valued and what how to show that they are valued and their differences are respected.

- Our school community
- Valuing and respecting one another
