<b>respect</b>	Being admired/highly thought of by someone.
<b>relationship</b>	the way in which two or more people/things are connected
<b>United Nations</b>	Global (world) organisation
<b>entitled</b>	Believing that you are deserving of something.
<b>opportunities</b>	Making it possible to do something.
<b>convention</b>	An agreement between countries.

- We all have roles, rights and responsibilities at home and school.
- Sharing these roles and responsibilities allows everyone to feel safe and cared for.

They are also important in ensuring stable and happy families. As well as this, the children will explore the United Nations Rights of the Child and how this is an established international set of rules to keep them safe from harm.
