Planning

Plan your sensory description before writing using the attached planning grid. Don't worry about long, complex sentences, just make bullet point notes. If you are stuck for ideas, take a look at the suggested websites and attached resources on the rainforests grid we sent out over the Easter holidays.

Writing

- -Use a separate paragraph for each sense (e.g. one for touch, one for sight etc.)
- -Include your thoughts and feelings as well what you can see, hear, touch and smell.
- -Write in the past tense (e.g. As I <u>forced</u> my way through the dense undergrowth, I <u>caught</u> a glimpse of a stealthy jaquar prowling silently on the damp ground.)
- -Include exciting vocabulary to really make your writing come alive especially adjectives for description (e.g. steamy, dense, vibrant, deadly.)

And, as always

- -Use a variety of sentence types (take a look at the Y5 sentence mats for ideas)
- -Include Year 5 SPaG features (e.g. relative clauses, punctuation for parenthesis)
- -Vary your punctuation.
- -Remember to self-edit your work e.g. check for spelling and punctuation errors, missing words. Have you used the correct the tense? Could you use a thesaurus to find a synonym for words such as 'good', 'beautiful'? Have you included many Year 5 SPaG features?
