Dear Families,

At school we believe that children thrive best when they feel happy and secure, both in school and at home. As a community, we have all faced difficult times over the past three years, and for some children and families this has been a particularly challenging time.

For this reason, we at Yorkmead have decided to buy into the services of Malachi Family Support. Malachi are a charitable organisation that offer a program of support to children and their families. They can work with one or both parents and carers to offer advice on how to support your child with issues such as bereavement, anxiety, stress, well-being, relationship and other difficulties. Where appropriate children may also be involved in the therapeutic sessions. This is therapeutic intervention intended to support children and their families through times of difficulty.

The intervention is fully funded by school and involves families being allocated a support worker, who will meet with families once a week at the same time for twelve weeks. Sessions can be arranged to suit you, either in school or at home.
