If your child has asthma/allergy please ensure they have an inhaler/medication in school otherwise they WILL NOT be able to go on the visit (please check the date on the inhaler/medication.)

Spending money can be taken, for when the children visit the souvenir shop. No more than £5. The cost for this visit is £19.00 per child. This cost includes a donkey ride and an ice-cream.

If insufficient funds are collected, then the visit will be cancelled.
