YEAR 2 TO WESTON - SUPER - MARE

All children will receive a free packed lunch from school. Please bring a bottle of water. Please return your lunch form by Monday 11th May 2026, otherwise your child **will NOT** receive a school packed lunch.

School uniform DOES NOT need to be worn.

Please ensure your child wears appropriate clothing for this time of year; layered clothing, t-shirt and good footwear being essential. In case of poor weather please ensure that your child has a waterproof jacket. On the back of this letter there is a list of what your child will need.

If your child has asthma/allergy please ensure they have an inhaler/medication in school otherwise they WILL NOT be able to go on the visit (please check the date on the inhaler/medication.)

Spending money can be taken, for when the children visit the souvenir shop. No more than £5.

The cost for this visit is £19.00 per child. This cost includes a donkey ride and an ice-cream. Payment for this visit must be made online. Please visit our website or the school office for details how to do this. If insufficient funds are collected, then the visit will be cancelled.

Please make your payment by Monday 11th May 2026. This is the final day in which to make a payment.
