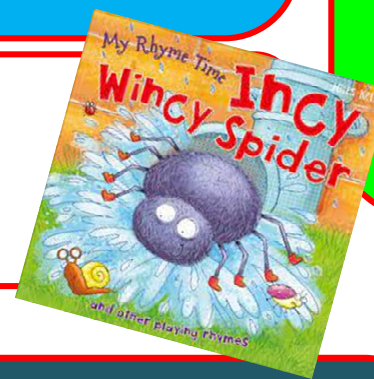
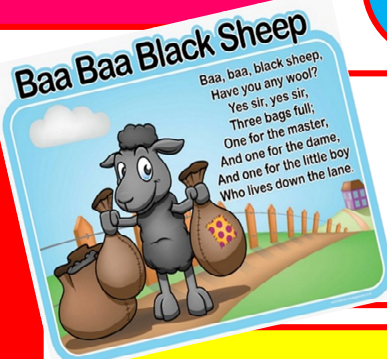
- To develop friendships with other children

Communication and Language

- To listen to simple stories
- To listen to other people's talk with interest

Physical Development

- To dress for outdoor wear e.g. putting on our coats

Literacy

- To look at books independently
- Phonics phase 1, aspects 1-6
- To make marks during play

Maths

- To learn simple counting up songs
- To talk about numbers in pictures
- To begin to count in 1's 1-5
- To begin to count small sets of objects that can be moved
- To talk about designs e.g. spotty/stripy
- To begin to learn the language of size 'big' and 'small/little'

Understanding the World

- To talk about who is in my family
- To become familiar with the nursery environment
- To use senses to explore natural materials
- To notice signs of Harvest
- Forest school
