

English: Our text for the term will be 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' and the 'Lighthouse Keeper's Cat' by Ronda & David Armitage

- Daily phonics/spelling sessions

Art: Expressive painting

We will be learning about artists who use expressive painting and also exploring different brush types.

Maths:

- Fractions- To be able to find $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of shapes. Also understanding that $\frac{2}{4}$ is equivalent to $\frac{1}{2}$. We will be finding fractions of shapes, objects and amounts.
- Time - Knowing units of time, telling the time to the hour, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Drawing the hands on a clock face to show time. Sequencing intervals of time.
- Problem solving lessons.

Science: Animals, including humans.

- Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air)
- Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene
