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Staircase Breathing

Safeguarding - YouTube

As our children explore the vast world of online content, ensuring their safety on platforms like YouTube is paramount. Here are some things you can do to keep children safe on YouTube:

- Start by activating YouTube's restricted mode to filter out inappropriate content.
- Create a supervised Google account for your child, allowing you to set content limitations and monitor their activity.
- Regularly communicate with your child about the importance of responsible online behaviour, emphasizing the need to avoid sharing personal information.
- Encourage them to use playlists curated by trusted adults or educational channels.
- Monitoring screen time is equally essential; establish reasonable limits to strike a balance between entertainment and other activities.

By fostering an open dialogue and implementing these precautions, we can help our children navigate YouTube safely and responsibly.
