It's soon to be the Autumn Disco! This will be held on **Thursday 2**nd **November.**


5-5.45pm for Reception and KS1 6-6.45pm for KS2.

Attendance Matters

It is vital that children are in school every day. This improves their chances of succeeding in school, ensures routine and enables the school the best chance to support your children. There are often misconceptions around absence from school and a wide range of myths regarding the impact. Below is a chart highlighting just how many days of absence is needed to drop into poor attendance and highlights how much education is missed once a child drops below 90%. This is why we will offer support before attendances gets to this point.
