This week, the children have been using 'The High Five Breathing' technique. This involves stretching one hand out in front of you like a star. Get the pointer finger of your other hand ready to trace your fingers up and down. Begin by placing your pointer finger on the palm of your hand. Breathe in as you trace up your fingers and breathe out as you trace down your fingers. Keep going until you have traced each finger with your breath. Please feel free to try this mindfulness at home too to establish calmness when needed.
