Our Phonics Scheme:

At Zouch Academy we teach our children the scheme called: Little Wandle- Letters and Sounds Revised.

Vocabulary: Here is the Phonics vocabulary that we teach to the children so that you are aware of the meanings and can use the same vocabulary at home.

GPC's- Grapheme phoneme correspondence.

Phoneme- What a 'sound' sounds like.

Grapheme- The written form of a sound.

Digraph- Two letters that are making one sound. E.g. 'ai'.

Trigraph- Three letters that are making one sound. E.g. 'igh'.

Blending- Blending the phonemes together after segmenting them.

Segmenting- Breaking the words down, one phoneme at a time.

Chunking- Splitting a longer word up to segment it.

Prosody- How we model expression and confident reading to the children.
