
## How safe do the children at Zouch feel?



## Main findings

- 24 children from years 1-6 were questioned.
- 100% of children said that they feel safe in school.
- 100% of children said they had trusted adults in school and could name at least two of these adults.
- 100% of adults said they had made a safeguarding hand and they could explain that this had names of people who could help to keep them safe.
- 100% of children said that they feel safe at playtimes.
- 84% of children could think of a value which linked to keeping safe with trust being the most popular answer, cooperation, patience and friendship were also ideas and explain why they thought this linked to a value.
- 100% of the children could say what they would do if they didn't feel safe.
- 100% of children demonstrated knowledge of how they keep safe online.
- 100% of the children said that they felt safe at home.
- 100% of children knew that all adults in the school had to wear lanyards and they could explain the colours of these (a couple of younger children said the things around your neck).
